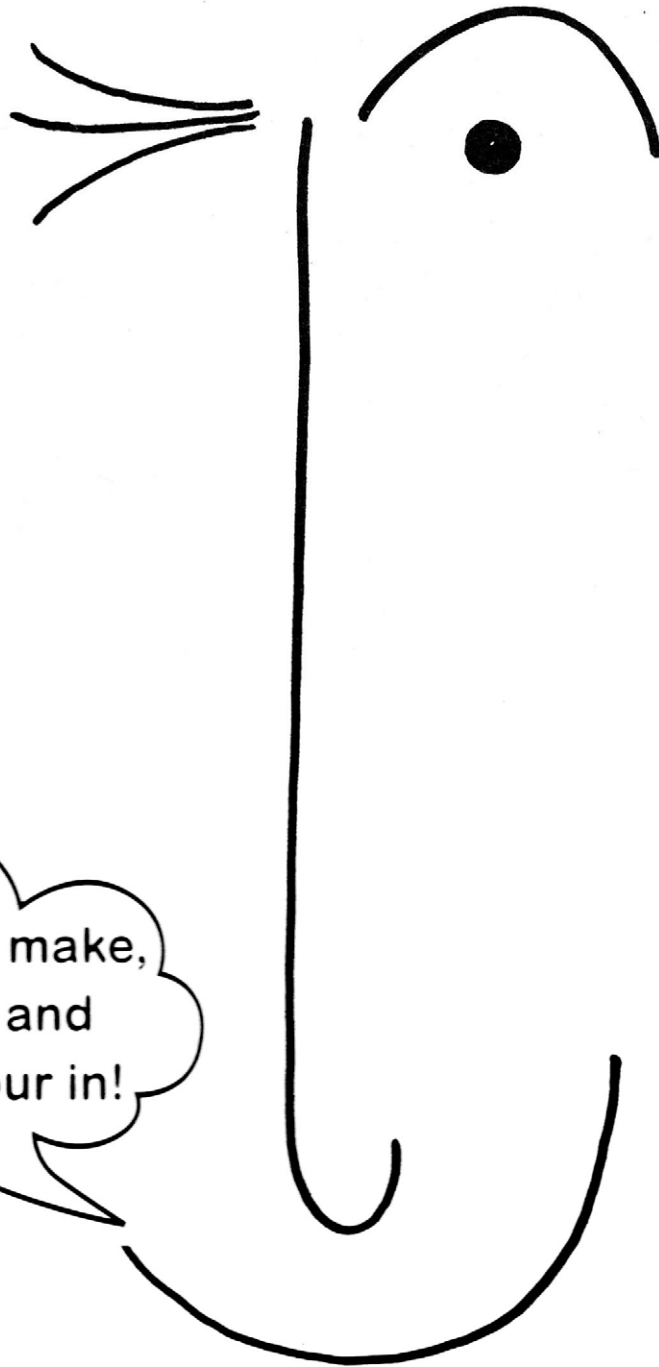

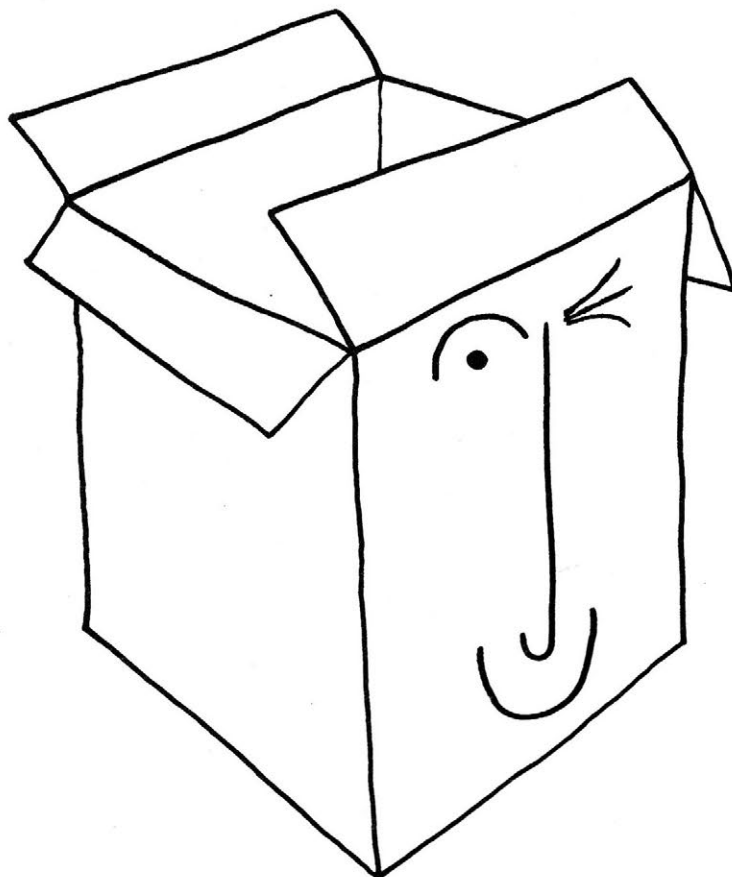
The Cardboard Box

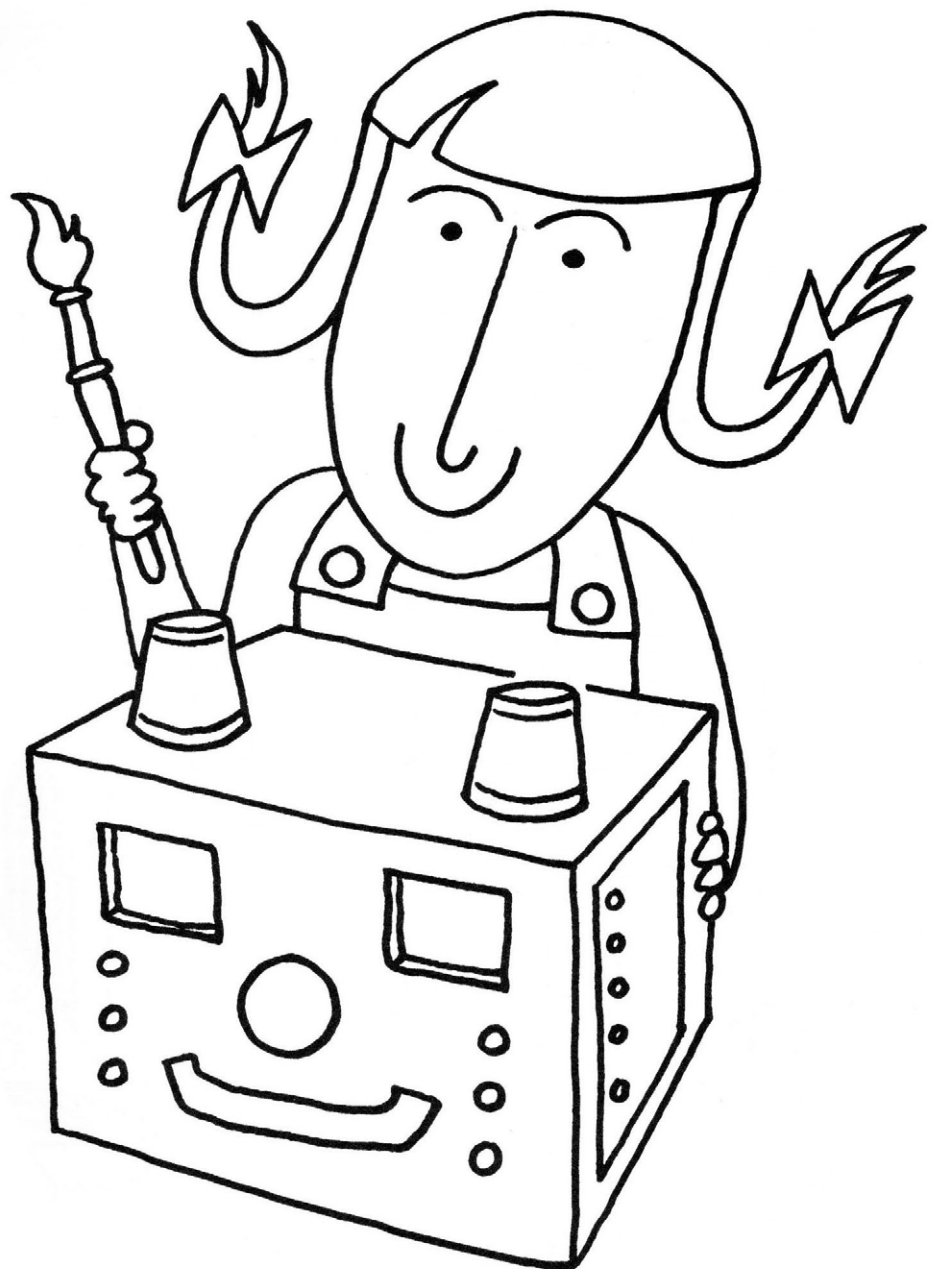

and Joseph will become a robot mask.

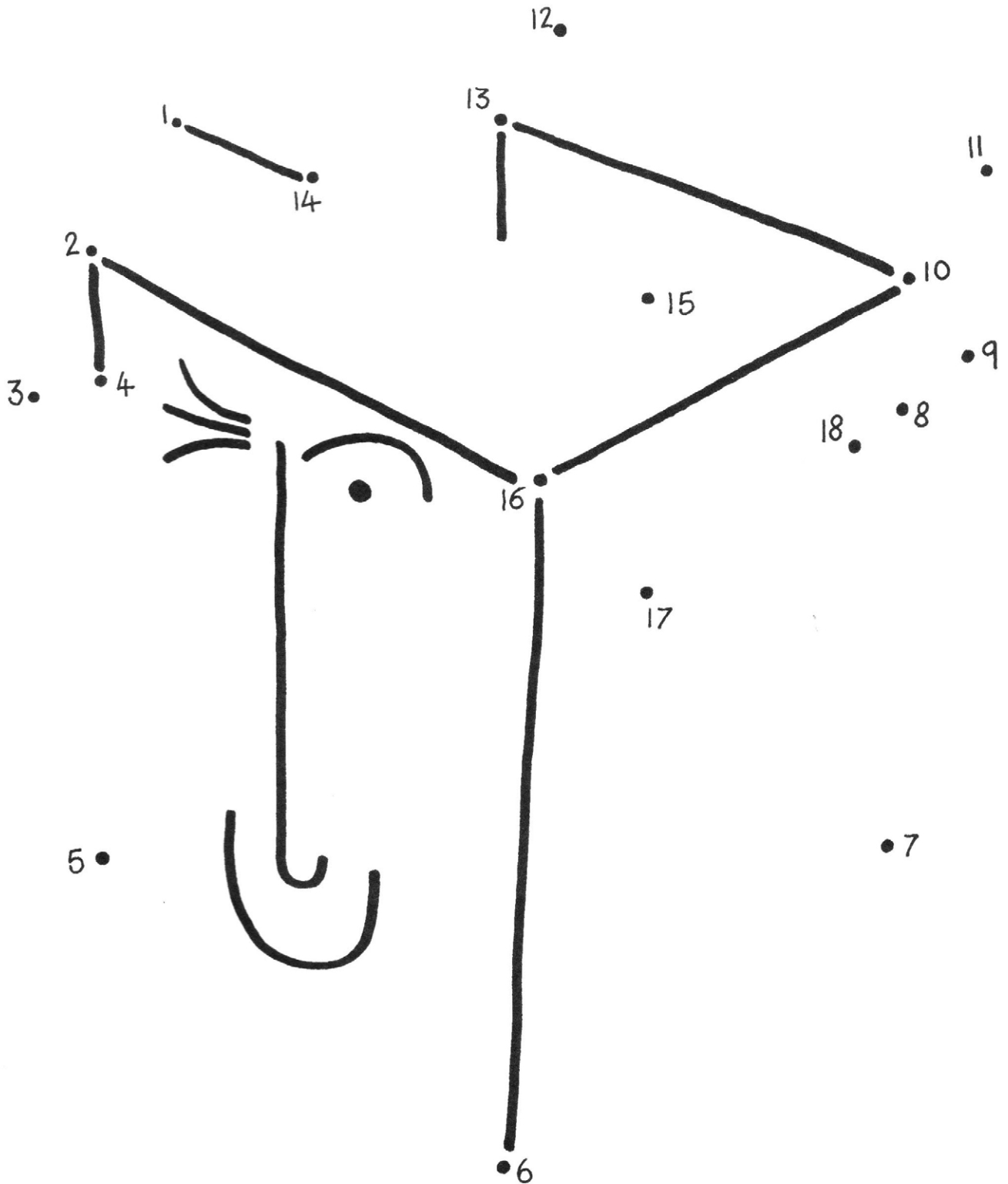


By taping some cardboard tubes onto the top corners and drawing on some windows and a drawbridge...

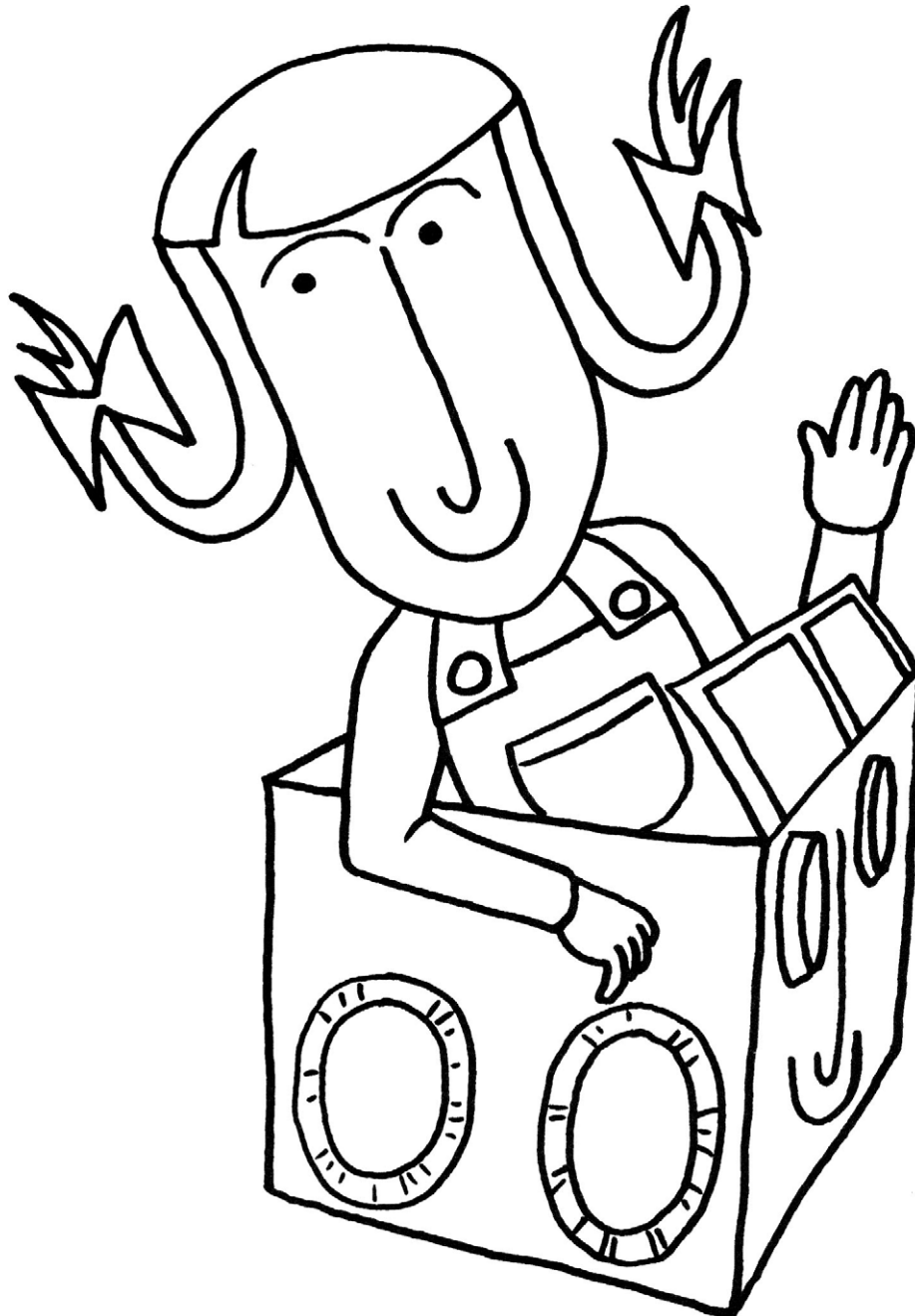

If you glue some tin foil pie cups on for headlights and paper plates for wheels...

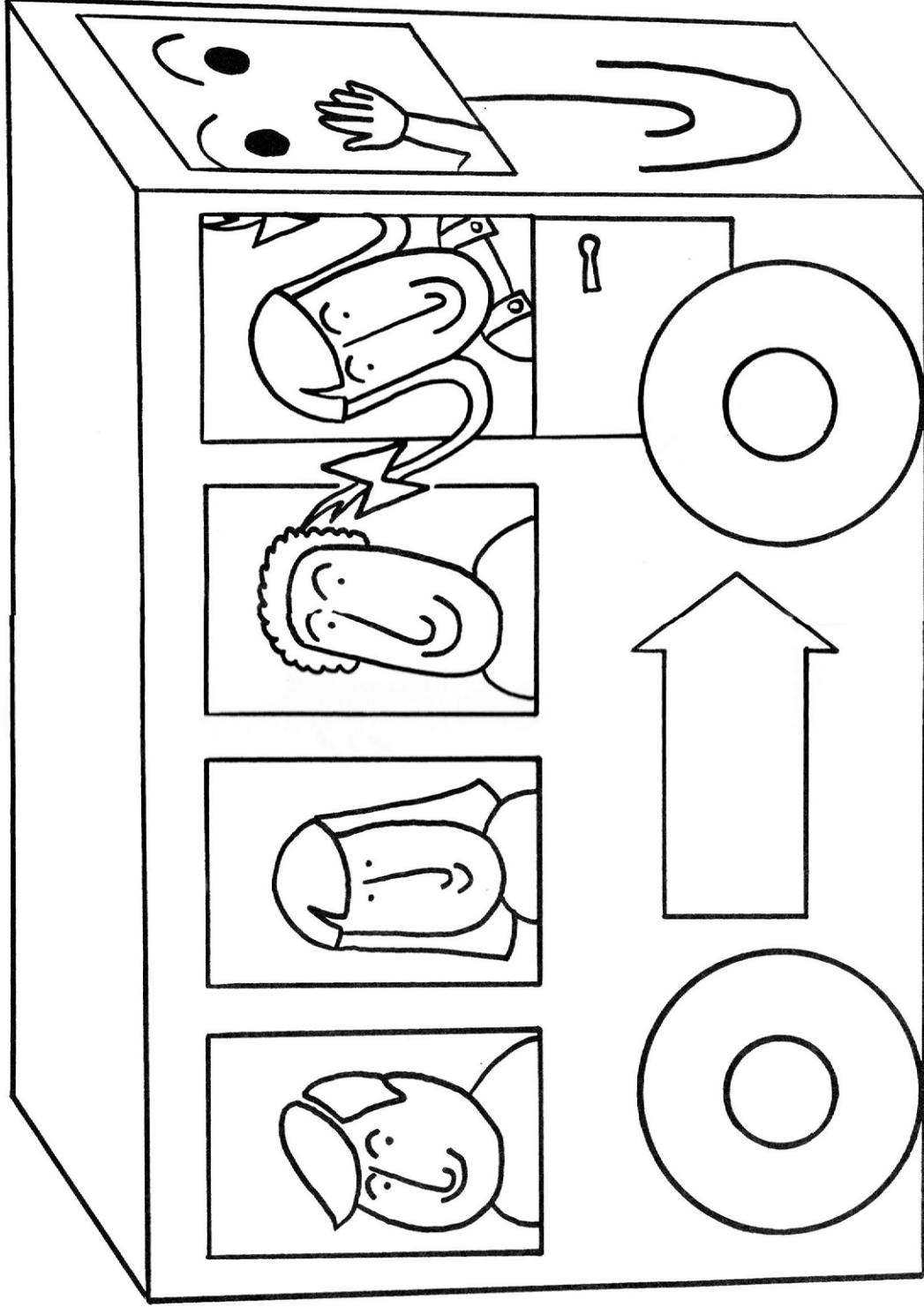
...Joseph turns into a motor car!

Stick some photographs of your friends and family in the windows.

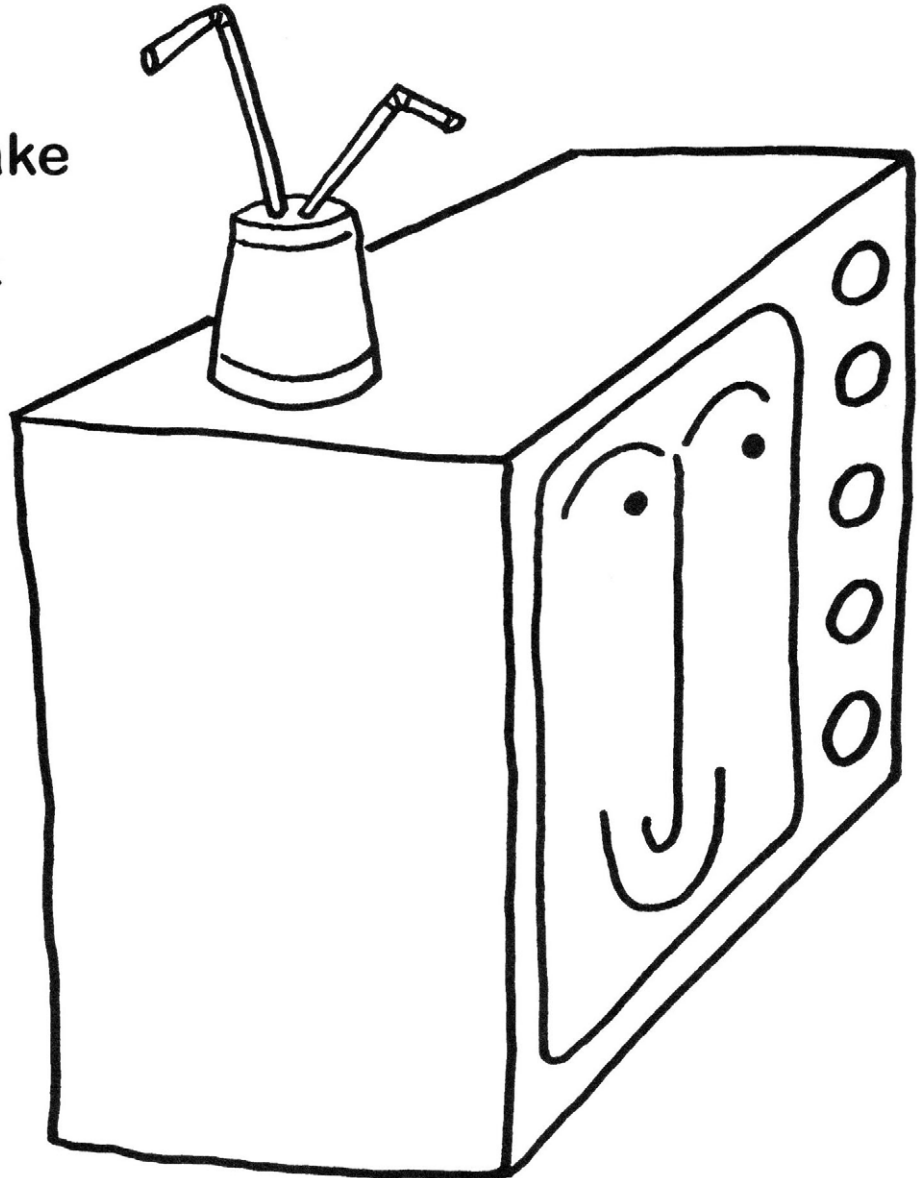

Make your box into a television set by drawing a square screen onto the front of it and sticking some bottle tops on for controls.

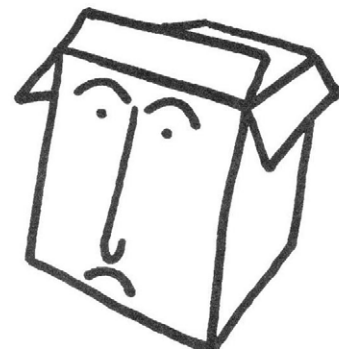
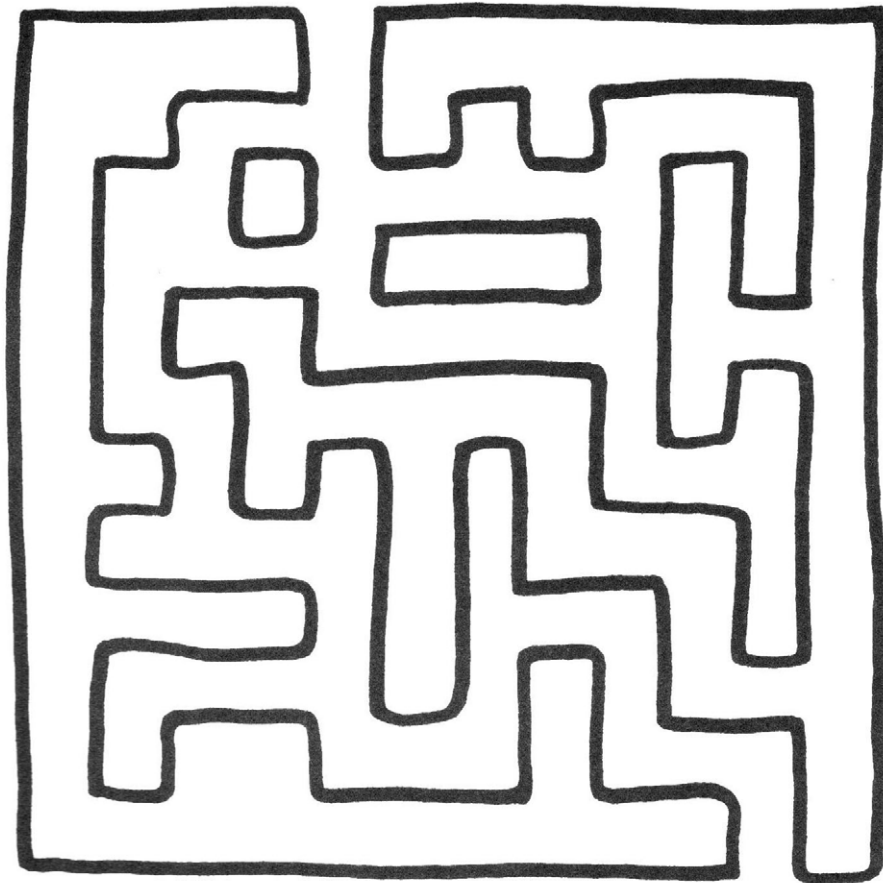
You could make the aerial out of a paper cup and some straws.



Draw a picture of your favourite cartoon onto the screen.

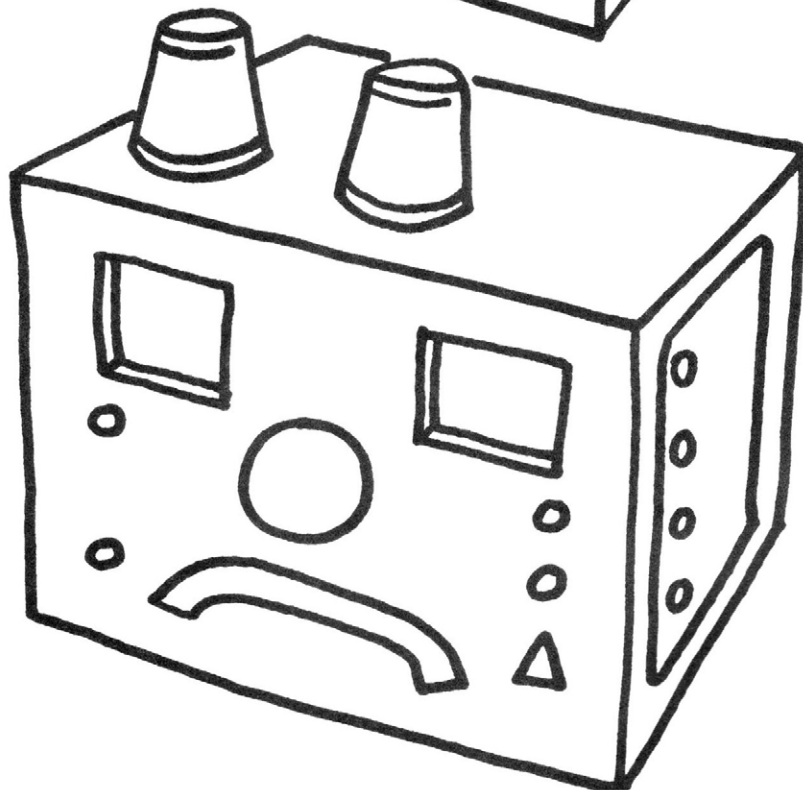
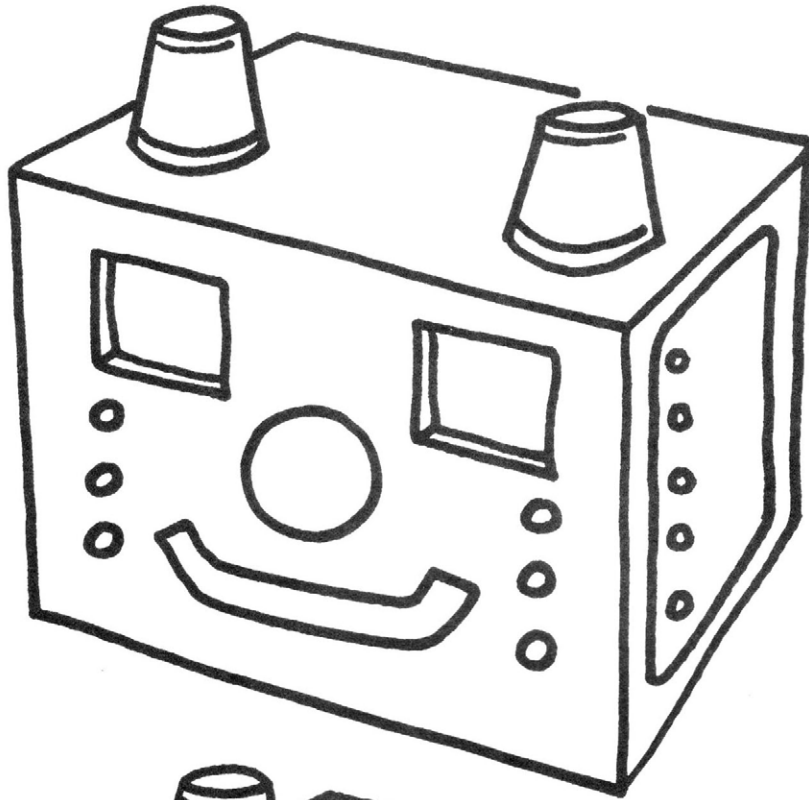
It's a-**MAZE**-ing what you can do with a cardboard box!

Help the little girl to find Joseph.



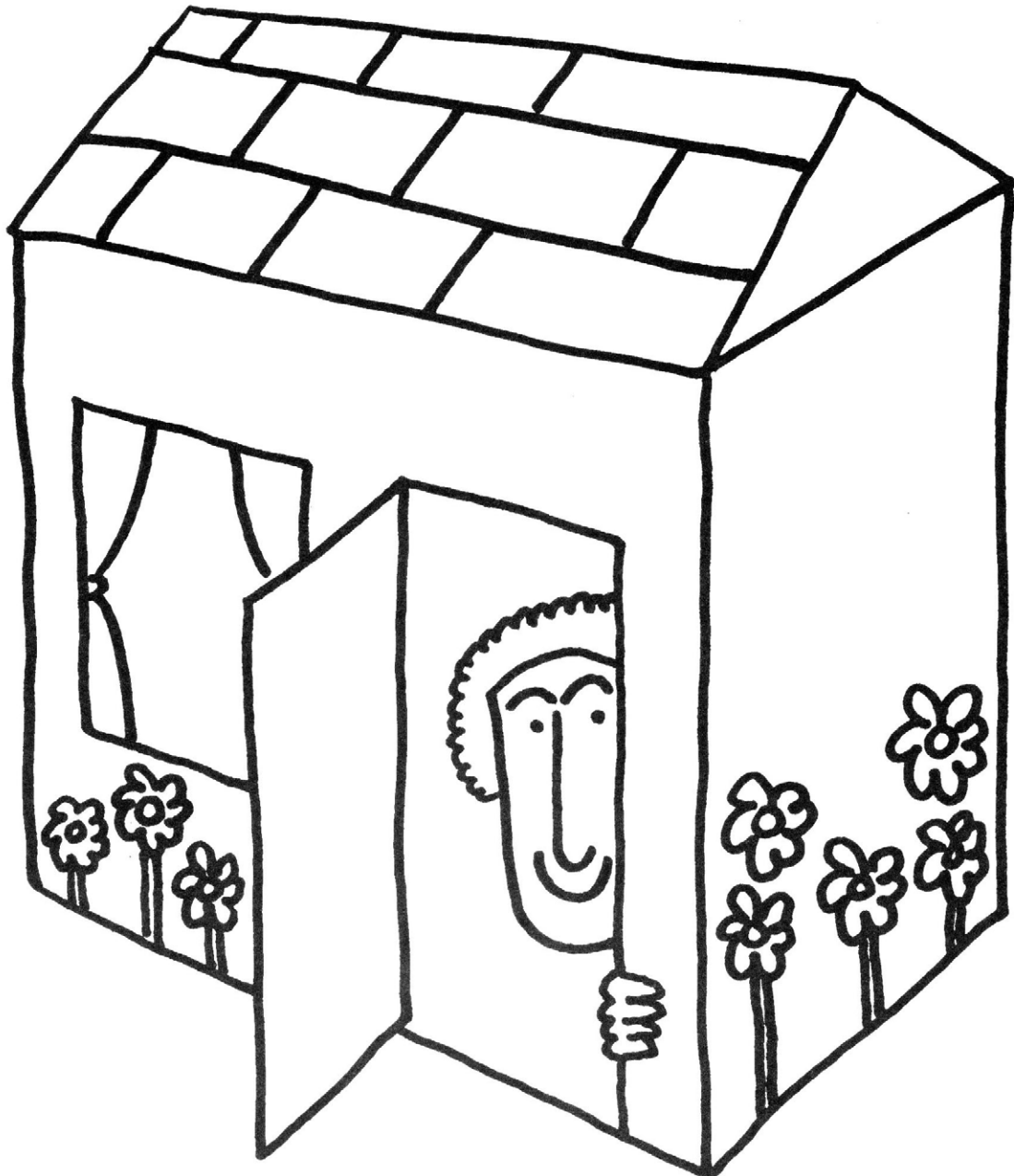
Spot the difference.
