

## Joseph The Cardboard Box

a robot mask.






By taping some cardboard tubes onto the top corners and drawing on some windows and a drawbridge...



a motor car!




# It's a-MAZE-ing what you can do with a cardboard box!

Help the little girl to find Joseph.




## Spot the difference.
