We were delighted to be able to work on several projects during the Summer holidays of 2022.

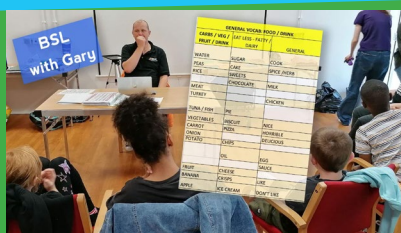
### Week 1: Stratton Street 'Arty Garden'

We worked with WV10 Consortium at Stratton Street Community Centre on the 'Arty Garden' Project...

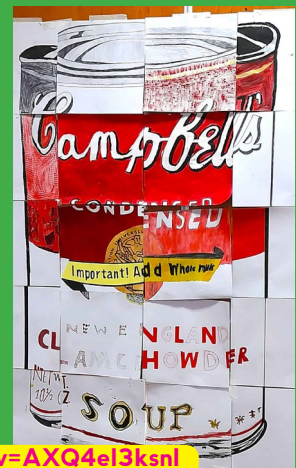


### Weeks 2-5: Summer HAF scheme

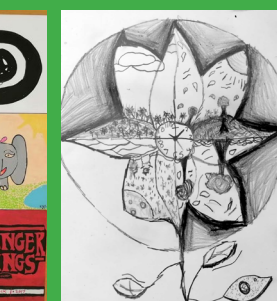

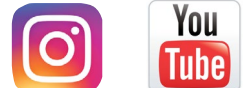
